## Steps to becoming a Volunteer

- 1. Download / Print & fill in the Volunteer Application Form
- 2. <u>Attend a drop-in information session</u> (check website for time & dates)
- 3. Hand in your Volunteer Application Form at the information session
- 4. Shift availability / events etc. are emailed

(if there is availability/opportunities)

- 5. Orientation shift is scheduled
- 6. Read the Volunteer Manual
- 7. Read and sign the Volunteer Agreement
- 8. Attend an Orientation shift
- 9. Discuss / agree volunteer shifts or other volunteer arrangements



## What is the main role of our Volunteers?

Sydney Dogs & Cats Home enjoys the support of many volunteers who <u>help</u> <u>create a happy and safe environment for our residents</u>. Our volunteers can be involved in all aspects of shelter life, including animal care, reception and administration duties, fundraising events and animal transport.

It is very important to us that all our staff and volunteers share the various required tasks. This ensures that everyone can enjoy both fun and rewarding experiences.



## Commitment

We ask our kennel volunteers to commit to <u>at least</u> one shift per fortnight for a period of 4 months. This means that volunteers gain the necessary skills to become a trusted member of our team <u>and</u> are able to provide the best care for our residents.

More shifts are possible, depending on availability of shifts and capability of an individual to perform tasks in a <u>fast paced environment</u>.

We ask all volunteers to commit to the shifts / events or tasks they have agreed to, communicating any changes or cancellation <u>in advance</u> (where possible).

## **Orientation Shift**

A typical Orientation Shift covers our basic volunteer kennel duties. This includes cleaning and performing animal handling duties. It also covers policies and procedures, general house rules and WHS (Work, Health & Safety) requirements.

We ask you to confirm your availability for future shifts and give a contribution of \$40, to cover training costs and a leash.

Before commencing your first shift, you will need to read the Volunteer Manual and sign the Volunteer Agreement.

Please bring photo ID with you also.



#### Other Information

SDCH is an impounding facility as well as an animal rehoming shelter. You may come into contact with some potentially confronting animal welfare situations. Please consider the emotional aspect of working in an environment such as this, before committing to a volunteer position.
