

SYDNEY DOGS & CATS HOME: COVID SAFE ADOPTIONS UPDATE

Sydney Dogs & Cats Home continues to provide safe adoption processes in the midst of the Greater Sydney Covid-19 outbreak.

Dr Renae Jackson, Animal Care Manager at Sydney Dogs & Cats Home further explains, "It is vital that we are able to continue operating, including returning lost animals to their owners and providing essential veterinary care. We are continuing to rehome animals while following all possible safety precautions; if we did not continue with adoptions then our shelter would quickly fill up and become overwhelmed. With this week's announcements including eight local LGA's moving into stricter lockdown restrictions, we are concerned that people are finding it more difficult to adopt new pets. Our contactless adoption process seeks to address this, by providing options that allow adoptions to continue but with minimal risk to our staff and the community".

The health and safety of our community, staff, volunteers and animals is our highest priority at all times. In light of the evolving COVID-19 stay at home orders affecting Greater Sydney, Sydney Dogs & Cats Home has implemented temporary measure in line with the directives by NSW Health agencies to ensure the safety of our community.

Sydney Dogs & Cats Home will be temporarily closed to the public for all non-essential services. Please be assured that our animals are continuing to receive high-quality care from our shelter staff during this time. This closure is to help minimise the amount of risk and exposure to our team and the wider community.

 - adoption finalisations

Reclaims

If you recognise your lost pet on our website, please phone our team. The reclaim process will then be conducted over the phone. Please do not go to our shelter until your contactless reclaim appointment is confirmed.

Adoptions

If you're interested in adopting a specific animal, please fill out an adoption form <u>online</u> and wait for our team to get in touch. The adoption process will then be conducted over the phone and via FaceTime. Please do not go to our shelter. If approved for adoption, an animal care team member will arrange contactless adoption finalisation and transport option, ensuring all physical distancing measures are adhered to.

Current Advice

The NSW Government has confirmed that veterinary services and animal welfare, care and accommodation services such as Sydney Dogs & Cats Home are an essential service.

The NSW Department of Primary Industries have clarified that you can leave your home when COVID-19 movement restrictions are in place to provide care to an animal.

Sydney Dogs & Cats Home is closely monitoring the evolving COVID-19 situation and will continue to follow the directives of the lead public health agencies, including NSW Health and the Australian Department of Health.
